- .5 credits health, .5 credits PE or 2 waivers, 1 fine art (or 2 sem. at the middle school), 3.5 credits electives = 20 credits total

Graduation Requirements for class of 2028

- 1) Get your 20 credits
- 2) Show competency (score of 684) by passing Alg. 1 and ELA 2 End of Course Exams

Earning Credits

- To be promoted to 10th grade earn at least 5 credits (in student handbook online p. 34)
- A credit is earned by passing a full year class or two semester classes
- Once a credit is earned, you will not lose it
- Have to repeat any required class you do NOT pass
