Overview:

Course Requirements:

1. You are required to take notes and keep all worksheets in order by date in your folder. You will be given an assignment sheet for each chapter or topic and all hand-outs must be listed on the assignment sheet. Your binder must be updated. There will be folder checks that will be graded after each chapter or topic.
2. You are responsible for completing classroom assignments in a timely fashion. Any work not completed in class will be assigned as homework.
3. Homework must be turned in on the day that it is due (at the start of class). Late homework will be scored with a 20% reduction for the first day - and 50% deduction after the first day. Homework that is 2 or more weeks late will not be counted at all—and receive a 0 grade.
4. Classroom participation will be graded daily and entered into Progressbook each Friday. Students can receive 2 participation points daily. Participation points are earned by: classroom preparedness (pencil - paper - charged Chromebook - in class on time) actively engaged in classroom activities/treat class with respect.
